Please return this form by Thursday, **March 4th**, with a \$45.00 deposit for each week for which you are registering your child. Full tuition will be \$85.00 per week. This deposit will be applied to the remainder of your full summer's tuition, due in one payment on the first day of camp each month. One month's notice will be required for refunds. Space is limited and registrations will be taken on a first come, first serve basis. We will only have **42 openings** per week. **There will be a \$20.00 Non-Refundable Registration fee for students not currently enrolled in Winters Chapel Preschool.**

Sessions will include a variety of activities focused around a weekly theme. We will meet from Monday through Thursday 9:30 to 1:00. We will make and eat theme-related snacks, research our themes, make an art or craft project, and spend lots of time outdoors. We will have several Thursday water days this summer.

Children will bring a lunch, a change of clothes (in case they get wet or dirty) and must wear tennis shoes. (Bark chips and sand get in sandals and annoy the children constantly.)
